ScanDent Services

Wesley Health Care Center helps reduce the loss or misplacement of dentures, hearing aids, and glasses through the use of ScanDent Services.

Radio frequency identification (RFID) tags can be attached to or embedded in dentures, glasses and hearing aids. Tags can easily be added or removed throughout your stay at Wesley. These tags are made of flexible metallic strips and tiny silicon chips, and they do not have a battery, do not emit any signal or radiation, and do not pose any health hazards. The tagging process takes a few minutes, and does not affect the fit, feel, strength, or durability of the dentures, hearing aids or glasses.

RFID checkpoints (scanners) are mounted at strategic locations throughout the buildings. These areas can detect dentures, hearing aids, and glasses that have been misplaced in linens, garbage bins, dressers, on food trays, and so forth.

If at any time a tagged item is misplaced and crosses one of nine checkpoints located throughout our facility, designated staff will be alerted and we will be able to find the item and return it to its owner.
