POOL RULES

It is our goal to provide you with a pool program that is both therapeutic and safe. Please take a few moments to read the following rules regarding the use of the pool.

1. Admittance to the pool area is allowed only when certified personnel are in the pool area or by special prior arrangement with the Instructor.
2. Due to safety concerns, the attending Instructor is unable to assist persons with dressing. Therefore, all participants must be able to dress/undress independently. If assistance is needed, participants are encouraged to have a family member or aide accompany them.
3. All participants are asked to provide their own towels.
4. All participants are required to rinse prior to entering the pool. If you would like to rinse after your pool session, please limit your shower to less than two (2) minutes. Please do not remove your bathing suit in the shower area.
5. All participants are asked to report any wounds, infections or illnesses to the supervising therapist prior to entering the pool. Please remove all bandages or Band-Aids prior to attending your scheduled appointment.
6. Disposable protective garments or paper products are not allowed in the pool, i.e., Attends feminine pads, tissues, regular diapers, etc. Children should wear swim diapers.
7. If, at any time, you develop incontinence such that you cannot control urination for the duration of the pool session, you will be unable to continue with pool treatment. There are bathroom facilities available in the pool area for use before and after the pool session.
8. The bathroom is reserved for toileting and therapist changing only.
9. All personal belongings should be stored in lockers. Participants may provide their own locker lock which must be removed after each session. We strongly urge that the lockers in the direct pool area be used as this allows the participant to use the next available changing area and help prevent back-up at the end of the session. The Wesley is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
10. No food or glass containers are allowed in the pool area. Water bottles are acceptable.
11. No diving allowed.
12. No running is allowed in the pool area.
13. Emergency alarms are located in the shower room, dressing rooms and bathroom.
14. A telephone is located at the pool entrance. For emergency assistance, dial "9" (wait for dial tone) and dial "911".
